TUCC PASTORAL SEARCH COMMITTEE COMMISSIONED

Dear Trinity UCC Singers,

Following the safety measures that are outlined below, we will hold our first in-person choir rehearsal, to be held in the Trinity church building, on Thurs Nov 5 starting at 7 pm and lasting about 30 minutes or so. Although we will have in-person weekly choir practices, for the foreseeable future we will NOT be

singing in-person in the actual worship service but rather our voices will be synthesized into a virtual choir video that will be played during the worship service and streamed for our Facebook community. We will also invite our choir members who are not able to join us in-person for choir rehearsals to join us by Zoom.

Please RSVP (MariBeth Brainerd @ mbwelch19@gmail.com) whether you will be able to attend choir practice on Nov 5, either in person or via zoom. Also, whether you would like to participate in our virtual choir/singers by submitting your own video of a song/hymn/anthem that you would like to share with the Trinity congregation.

Finally - invite friends!! Surely there must be other singers in our congregation -- also invite friends who are not (yet) part of Trinity -- to be part of our virtual choir!! It's a great chance to learn some new music and also sing old favorites under Cammeron's inspiring direction!

Mask wearing, hand washing, and distancing is the best practices. Please take temperatures and keep a list of all those present each time the building is occupied. You will need to sanitize all surfaces you have come into contact with when finished for the evening. Research today at CDC states ventilation with fresh air helps to remove aerosol particles of the virus that may linger if the air is still. Opening a window and turning on the ceiling fans will help refresh the air while you are there. Please keep close contact (within 6 feet) to less than fifteen minutes (always have a mask on at close distance). There is no way to remove 100% of possible viral particles but these practices demonstrate we take our safety seriously.
