Pastor: O God, we hear your voice and we see the way of Jesus set before us.


ALL: But it's hard, dear God, to try again and again to live up to our baptismal vows and maintain our resolve to be your people in the world.

Overview:

For some people today, even those who profess Christ and seek to follow Jesus, the 'Dark' is an enemy, an ever-challenging space to encounter.

The profound, encouraging, and challenging words of the Psalmist in Psalms 139:12

("...even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is as bright

as the day, for darkness is as light to you.") can both invite us to open ourselves to god's light when we are afraid in the dark and 'smack' us gently to awaken our spiritual gifts and resources that allow us to see God's 'safety-net' in the night.
